

CLOSE CONTACT NOTIFICATION INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES

- ☐ Your student may have had close contact (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) in the last 14 days with someone **diagnosed with or exhibiting major symptoms of COVID-19.** Major symptoms include:

 New unusual cough, new loss of taste or smell, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath.
- ★ If your student has been determined to have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID19 or someone exhibiting major symptoms, they should remain out of school for 14 days since the last known contact.
- ★ If your student becomes symptomatic during this time, have them evaluated by their healthcare provider/doctor and report to the school nurse the results and outcome of the medical evaluation.
- ★ If your student tests positive during this time and remains asymptomatic, he or she can return to school after it has been at least 10 days since the positive test result.
- ★ If your student tests negative during this time, they must complete the full 14 days of quarantine.
