

Details on Learning Options

for the 2020-2021 school year

Blended Students on Staggered Schedule

- By August 18th, students will receive instruction on accessing remote content.
- Content for remote instruction will consist of videos, lessons, and learning games aligned to the Alabama Course of Study Standards and designed for ongoing learning.
- Students working remotely will be able to access content at the time of their choosing. Teachers will assign daily lessons and students are expected to complete work each day. Since students work at differing speeds, no set times for learning will be given.
- All content for remote instruction will consist of videos, lessons, and learning games aligned to the Alabama Course of Study Standards and designed for ongoing learning. Work may consist of the following:
 - Edgenuity Courseware for grades 6-12
 - Odysseyware for grades 3-5
 - Teacher created content for grades K-12
- Teachers will have office hours on Wednesdays and will have a weekly Google Meet.

1st-5th grade students:

- Students will login to Google Classroom Monday Friday and work on remote assignments. Assignments will be graded.
- Students may attend the once per week enrichment activity.
 - Parents will be notified when this will begin

6th-12th grade students:

- On campus class schedule will be confirmed with student prior to August 19th.
- Monday and Tuesday: Students A-L will attend scheduled traditional classes on campus and leave after traditional opportunities.
- <u>Thursday and Friday:</u> Students M-Z will attend scheduled traditional classes on campus and leave after traditional opportunities.
- Monday Friday: All remote assignments will be completed at home.
- Traditional and remote assignments will be graded and applicable credits granted.
